Dedicated to a truly student-focused pedagogy, BSB put its students first.


At a time when many of the French Grandes Ecoles have embarked on a race to expansion, BSB stands for an alternative model: a close-knit community in a school with a human touch.

THE PROGRAMME

The 2022 Summer School module:

AUTHENTIC LEADERSHIP AND ENTREPRENEURIAL CREATIVITY



PROGRAMME CONTENT

Our Summer school is an innovative workshop programme. The workshop concept combines modern learning methods such as experiential learning, problem-based learning, elements of personal development, and a number of creativity techniques. It is built on three learning pillars: Entrepreneurial thinking, Leadership and Creativity, which are stimulated every day. The programme allows students to develop their personal leadership potential and better access their creative potential in their professional and personal life.

The programme has a strong focus on personal development and soft skills. It aims at stimulating a human centered leadership based on students' awareness of their personal strengths and unique qualities as human beings. We also build on the group dynamic to create in-depth interactions and learning from each other.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

- Understanding entrepreneurial thinking and effectuation
- Being aware of my personal leadership qualities
- Learning to be a human-centered leader
- Knowing how to understand a problem and its context
- Knowing how to select and apply a number of creativity techniques
- Learning to think visually and seek feedback for ideas

PROGRAMME ASSESSMENT

50% individual learning diary:

Students document throughout the week their personal learning from the programme.

The objective is not to reproduce knowledge from the workshop, but to stimulate critical observation and reflection of their personal progress and how their experience -virtual or face-to-face- has impacted them.

We support any creative and free format for the learning diary and do not set a minimum or maximum length.

The major evaluation criteria are authenticity and depth of their reflection.

50% final team presentation:

Throughout day 3 and 4, students work on an entrepreneurial challenge in a small diversity-based team. They make use of their empathy, critical thinking and creative resources to develop an innovative solution to a challenge.

On day 5, each team gives a 10minutes presentation of their project, using any form of visual aid available to them (movies, posters, pictures, prototypes).

Focus of the evaluation is not only on the end result, but on the process of how students explored, analysed and handled an entrepreneurship challenge.

PROGRAMME CREDITS

Face-to-face Summer School 2022:

The in-person programme is credited with 6 ECTS and contains 25 contact hours with a lecturer during the 5 days.

Online Summer School 2022:

The online programme is credited with 4 ECTS and contains 20 contact hours with a lecturer during 4 days.

A certificate of completion, along with an official transcript of results, will be provided to your home university after the end of the programme.



FACE-TO-FACE SESSION

ACCOMMODATION

BSB organises optional accommodation during the programme.

Students can choose between a single or twin room in the Adagio Aparthotel (or similar according to availability) located in the centre of Dijon and just minutes' walk from the Business School. This is a 3 star hotel and breakfast will be included in the reservation.

Accommodation is booked from 18th June to allow students time to arrive, meet classmates and partake in the cultural visit before the programme starts.

Please note the cost of accommodation is not included in the cost of the programme and must be funded separately.

THE ENTREPRENEURIAL GARDEN (TEG)

OPTIONAL CULTURAL VISIT

June 19, 2022

BSB organises an enriching field trip experience to the beautiful city of Beaune.

Located a little under 50km from Dijon, Beaune is well known for its vineyards and has close links with BSB.

This visit will involve several cultural activities, such as a visit to a local Hôpital-Dieu, a tour of a traditional French château, and a wine tasting and will include lunch in a restaurant.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The programme is suitable for both postgraduate and undergraduate students.

The programme has both a strong practical and personal development orientation. We are thus looking for students with a certain degree of personal maturity. Some professional experience is required (internships are sufficient) in order to benefit from introspection exercises and to work on business challenges.

An excellent level of English is also required, since the programme is taught exclusively in English and is highly interactive. (Please note: evidence of sufficient English level may be required.)

We would normally expect to have around 20 students taking part in each session, to allow sufficient group interaction as well as individual attention.

PAYMENT
